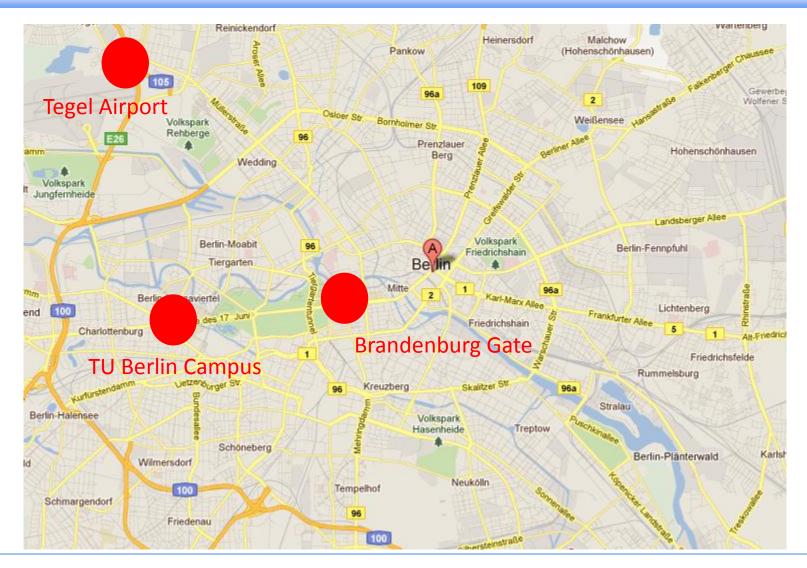

Local Information: Berlin

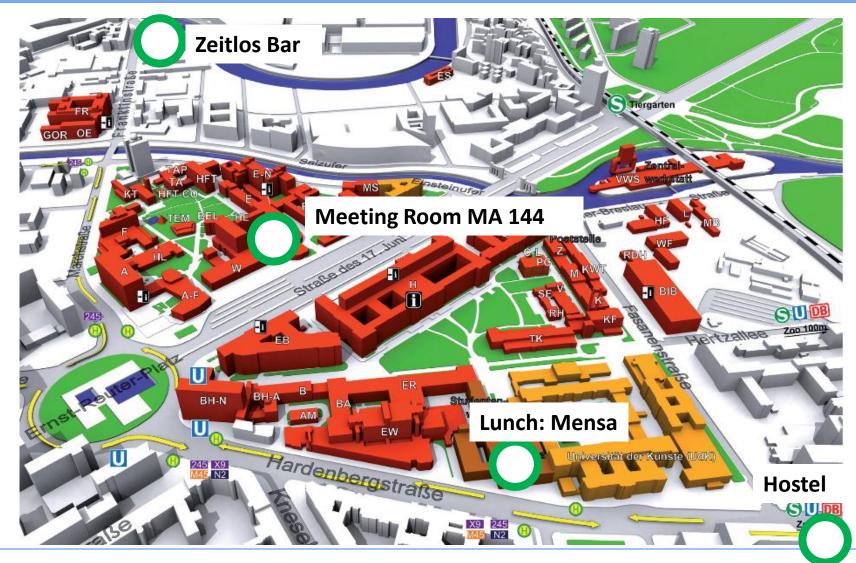






Local Information: Campus Map
